COMMISSION REPORTS

FINANCE: Dan Meade gave this month's report.

- Expenses and revenue in line with budget. Collections have been better this year than last year this time.
- 365 Raffle – 1275 tickets sold, break even is 955 tickets sold. The goal is to sell 2,000 tickets which would allow a \$20,000 profit.
- Finance, Parish Council, and Education Commission to meet in January to set tuition.

- Need volunteers for St. Jude open house on Jan. 31 to give tours.
- Per Tom Tressler, there have been a few responses for the teacher fund .
- Education Commission looking into a possible after-school Algebra program to expose 8th grade students to Algebra.

- Advent wreath family day was well attended and a success. Eight 8th grade students helped children at the craft tables. They did a great job helping!
